

GOVERNMENT RESOLUTION NO. 19/2010

Creation of the Commission to Monitor the Promotion Process in the National Police of Timor-Leste

The transitional period for promotions in the National Police of Timor-Leste (PNTL) ended with the approval of the promotions by the IV Constitutional Government by way of Government Resolution No. 19 of 24 March 2010.

The work of the Secretariat for Supporting the Promotion Commission showed that it was necessary to create a commission to monitor and support the implementation of the decided promotions in the PNTL and to collect and review information, propose solutions to the Government and assist in their implementation. Therefore,

Under section 115.1 (c) and (o) of the Constitution, the Government decides the following:

1. Create the Commission to Restructure the National Police of Timor-Leste.
2. The Commission has the following tasks:
 - Support the implementation of the promotions approved by Resolution No. 20/2010 of 24 March;
 - Support the resolution of delayed promotions;
 - Support the resolution of cases of PNTL members who have not been assigned positions;
 - Support the start of the Promotion Commission foreseen in Decree-Law No. 16/2009 of 18 March;
 - Inform the Government in relation to the promotion implementation process;
 - Collect and review information on the various areas of the PNTL and propose solutions to the Government and assist their implementation.
3. The Commission shall have duration of one year, starting on the date the present diploma enters into force.
4. The present Resolution enters into force on the day immediately after its publication.
