**DIRECTIVE NO. 2000/3**

**ON THE DEFINITION OF STREET PEDDLERS AND MARKET HAWKERS**

The Special Representative of the Secretary-General (hereinafter: Transitional Administrator),

Pursuant to the authority given to him under United Nations Security Council resolution 1272 (1999) of 25 October 1999,

Taking into account United Nations Transitional Administration in East Timor (UNTAET) Regulation 1999/1 of 27 November 1999 on the Authority of the Transitional Administration in East Timor,

Pursuant to UNTAET Regulation No. 2000/4 of 20 January 2000 on the Registration of Businesses,

Promulgates the following:

Section 1

Definition of street peddlers and market hawkers

For the purposes of UNTAET Regulation No. 2000/4, 'street peddlers or market hawkers' means businesses which:

- (a) are engaged in business activity which is exclusively retail in nature; and
- (b) have no fixed and permanent place of business; and
- (c) have a monthly turnover of less than US \$200.

Section 2  
Entry into force

The present directive shall enter into force on 14 April 2000.
