DIRECTIVE NO. 2001/11

**ON AMENDING DIRECTIVE 2001/05 OF 5 JUNE 2001 ON THE PROCEDURES FOR
THE REGISTRATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN EAST TIMOR**

The Special Representative of the Secretary-General (hereinafter: Transitional Administrator),

Pursuant to the authority given to him under United National Security Council Resolution 1272 (1999) of 25 October 1999, as reaffirmed in United Nations Security Council Resolution 1338 (2001) of 31 January 2001,

Taking into account United Nations Transitional Administration in East Timor (UNTAET) Regulation No. 2001/06 of 5 June 2001 on the Registration of Motor Vehicles in East Timor establishing a regime for the registration and the issuance of license plates for motor vehicles in East Timor,

For the purpose of amending UNTAET Directive 2001/05 of 5 June 2001 on the Procedures for the Registration of Motor Vehicles in East Timor with respect to the format of characters placed thereon,

Promulgates the following:

Section 1

Section 10.5 (f) of Directive No. 2001/05 is amended to provide as follows:

Licence plates for all other motor vehicles shall;

(ii) have five (5) Arabic numerals with a diamond (?) between the second and third numeral followed by two (2) Alpha characters denoting the district of origin of the motor vehicle.

Section 2

A Section 10.5 (g) is added to Directive No. 2001/05 and provides as follows:

Licence plates for motorcycles shall have four (4) Arabic numerals followed by two (2) Alpha characters denoting the district of origin of the motorcycle.

Section 3

The present Directive shall be deemed to have become effective on 5 June 2001.
