



## DIRECTIVE NO. 2002/6

### ON THE REMUNERATION OF THE COMMISSIONERS AND STAFF OF THE COMMISSION FOR RECEPTION, TRUTH AND RECONCILIATION IN EAST TIMOR

The Special Representative of the Secretary-General (the “Transitional Administrator”),

Pursuant to the authority given to him under United National Security Council resolution 1272 (1999) of 25 October 1999, as reaffirmed in United Nations Security Council resolution 1338 (2001) of 31 January 2001,

Taking into account UNTAET Regulation No. 2001/10 of 13 July 2001 on the Establishment of a Commission for Reception, Truth and Reconciliation in East Timor (the “Commission”) and the appointment of National Commissioners, Regional Commissioners and staff of the Commission,

For the purpose of prescribing the remuneration of the National Commissioners, Regional Commissioners and staff of the Commission in accordance with, respectively, Section 4.7, Section 11.10 and Section 34.1 of UNTAET Regulation No. 2001/10 on the Establishment of a Commission for Reception, Truth and Reconciliation in East Timor,

After consultation with the Council of Ministers,

Promulgates the following:

#### Section 1 Definitions

In addition to terms defined in the *Regulation* and used in the present Directive, for the purposes of, and wherever used in, the present Directive, the following terms shall have the following meanings:

(a) “*Executive Director*” means the Executive Director of the Commission appointed by and serving the Commission in the capacities generally described in Section 4.1 of the present Directive.

(b) “*National Commissioner*” means a Commissioner appointed by the Transitional Administrator pursuant to Section 4.2 of the *Regulation*.

(c) “*Regional Commissioner*” means a Commissioner appointed by the Transitional Administrator pursuant to Section 11.1 of the *Regulation*.

(d) “*Regulation*” means UNTAET Regulation No. 2001/10 of 13 July 2001 on the Establishment of a Commission for Reception, Truth and Reconciliation in East Timor.

(e) “*staff*” means the staff of the Commission appointed by the Commission pursuant to Section 3.4(b) of the *Regulation* in order to achieve the objectives of the Commission.

## Section 2

### Remuneration for National Commissioners

2.1 Each *National Commissioner* shall receive a base remuneration of US\$600 per month of service with the Commission.

2.2 In accordance with Section 4.7 of the *Regulation*, the base remuneration of each *National Commissioner* as set forth in Section 2.1 of the present Directive shall be pro rated in proportion to the time dedicated by such *National Commissioner* to Commission work.

## Section 3

### Remuneration for Regional Commissioners

Each *Regional Commissioner* shall receive remuneration of US\$450 per month of service with the Commission.

## Section 4

### Remuneration for the Executive Director of the Commission

4.1 The *Executive Director* shall be that person appointed by the Commission, pursuant to Section 3.4(b) of the *Regulation*, responsible for the overall management of the administration of the Commission.

4.2 The *Executive Director* shall receive remuneration of US\$600 per month of service with the Commission.

## Section 5

### Remuneration for staff of the Commission

5.1 The members of the *staff* of the Commissioner shall receive monthly remuneration, pro rated on the basis of 30 days per month for partial months of service, in accordance with the following:

5.2 For purposes of this Section 5, *staff* remunerated at Level 7 shall be limited to those senior managers responsible for the coordination of a department or departments of the Commission and constituting, together with the *Executive Director*, the Senior Management Team of the Commission.

Section 6  
Entry into force

The present Directive shall enter into force on 29 April 2002, to be effective as of 21 January 2002.
