ON FEES IN RELATION TO WATER SERVICES

The Transitional Administrator,

Pursuant to the authority given to him under United Nations Security Council Resolution 1272 (1999) of 25 October 1999,

For the purposes of establishing a Schedule of user charges in relation to water services under Directive No. 2000/6,

Hereby notifies the following:

The Schedule of user charges in relation to water services as set forth in the attachment shall be effective as from 1 January 2000, until replaced or modified.

The present notification will be published in the Official Gazette of East Timor, pursuant to UNTAET Regulation No. 1999/4.

FEES IN RELATION TO WATER SERVICES

Scope of Fees

1.1 A fee shall be levied for the use of water supplied by UNTAET.

1.2 The occupier of the premises being metered or where the water usage has been otherwise calculated shall be liable to pay the fees for water.

Section 2 Level of Fees

The fees payable shall be US\$1.10 per kilolitre (kL).

Section 3 Application of Fees

3.1 Fees shall be payable where usage exceeds 800 kL of water per month, except that no fees shall be payable where the premises are principally used for long-term residential accommodation.

3.2 Where meters fail or metering is not feasible, assessments for bills shall be made using a reasonable and defensible methodology, and this methodology shall be explained to customers.

Section 4 Payment of fees

Fees levied pursuant to this Schedule shall be paid into the account of the Central Fiscal Authority at the Central Payment Office or its nominated agent within fourteen (14) calendar days of the date of the bill issued in accordance with Section 4 of the present Directive.

Section 5 Other Fees and Charges

Until further notice, no charges shall be levied for connection fees or supplies from overhead filling stations.
