On the temporary assignment of Judges Cirilo Jose J.V. Cristovao and Carmelita Moniz to the Court of Appeal in East Timor

The Transitional Administrator, pursuant to United Nations Security Council Resolution 1272 (1999) of 25 October 1999, as reaffirmed in United Nations Security Council Resolution 1338 (2001) of 31 January 2001, for the purposes of implementing UNTAET Regulations 2000/11, 2000/15, 2000/16 and 2000/30,

Hereby notifies:

Following consultations with and recommendations from the Transitional Judicial Services Commission, as established under Regulation No. 1999/3, and in accordance with United Nations Security Council Resolution 1272 (1999),

I appoint,

- Cirilo Jose J.V. Cristovao Judge at the Dili District Court, as an Acting Judge of the Court of Appeal; and
- Carmelita Moniz Judge at the Dili District Court, as an Acting Judge of the Court of Appeal.

The appointments are valid until 30 September 2001 unless further extended by me.

During the period of the temporary appointment, the appointees will continue to perform their normal duties at the Dili District Court, and they will participate as Judges of the Court of Appeal on a case by case basis, when summoned by the President of the Court of Appeal.

These appointments shall take effect on 6 June 2001.

The present notification will be published in the Official Gazette of East Timor, pursuant to UNTAET Regulation No.1999/4.
