**ON THE EXTENSION OF THE INITIAL PERIODS OF
APPOINTMENT OF CERTAIN JUDGES AND PROSECUTORS**

The Transitional Administrator,

Pursuant to the authority given to him under United Nations Security Council Resolution 1272 (1999) of 25 October 1999, as reaffirmed in United Nations Security Council Resolution 1338 (2001) of 31 January 2001,

For the purposes of establishing an independent judiciary and in response to the need to provide judicial services in East Timor,

Taking into account Section 28 of UNTAET Regulation No. 2000/11 on the Organization of the Courts in East Timor, as amended, and,

Taking into account Section 6 of UNTAET Regulation No. 2000/16 on the Organization of the Public Prosecution Service in East Timor, as amended,

Hereby notifies the following:

(1) The initial period of appointment of the following judges is extended until 20 May 2002, or for such period as may otherwise be provided by law:



(3) The extensions of the periods of time provided herein are effective as of the dates on which the previous Notifications appointing the said judges and prosecutors lapsed.
