ON THE AUTHORIZATION OF LEGAL REPRESENTATIVES IN CERTAIN COURT PROCEEDINGS

The Transitional Administrator,

Pursuant to the authority given to him under United Nations Security Council Resolution 1272 (1999) of 25 October 1999, as reaffirmed in United Nations Security Council Resolution 1338 (2001) of 31 January 2001,

For the purposes of ensuring the proper administration of justice,

Taking into account Section 27 of UNTAET Regulation No. 2000/11 on the Organization of the Courts in East Timor, as amended,

Noting that certain parties in proceedings before the Courts of East Timor, following request made for legal representation of their own choosing, have been advised, by the Office of Deputy Prosecutor General for Ordinary Crimes, that they should submit a request to this effect to the Transitional Administrator, and,

Pursuant to the request of the said parties duly made,

Hereby notifies the following:

In any civil and criminal proceedings presently filed with or before the Dili District Court and any related proceedings involving the following parties:

JJ McDonald and Sons Engineering Pty. Ltd. ('JMS') trading under the business name East Timor Constructions; Christopher Roy Greig; and, Paul Gerard McDonald (hereinafter, 'the parties'),

The parties have the right to be represented before the Courts of East Timor by the following legal counsel:

- Colin McDonald, QC of William Forster Chambers, Darwin Northern Territory, Member of the Victorian Bar and the Northern Territory Bar in the Commonwealth of Australia;
- Associate Professor Timothy Lindsey of the Asian Law Centre, University of Melbourne, Member of the Victorian Bar in the Commonwealth of Australia;
- Keith Ronald Kern of Boulton Cleary & Kern, Townsville, Queensland in the Commonwealth of Australia; and,
- Jeffrey Keith Guy, of Boulton Cleary & Kern, Townsville, Queensland in the Commonwealth of Australia

And by any other legal counsel duly registered at a bar or professional society of legal practitioners, recognized by the competent authorities of the country or jurisdiction of that bar or professional society.
